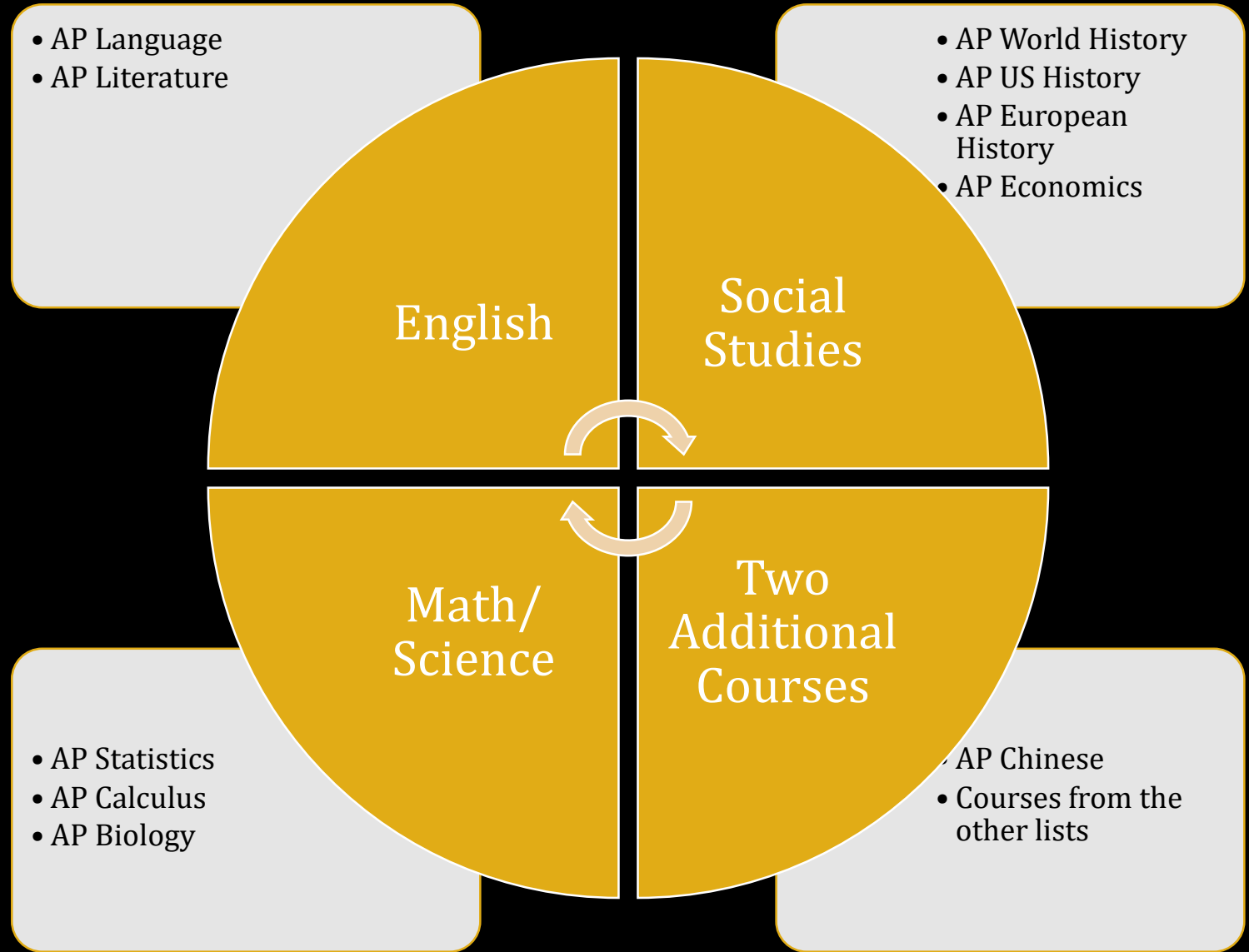

These are the minimum graduation requirements

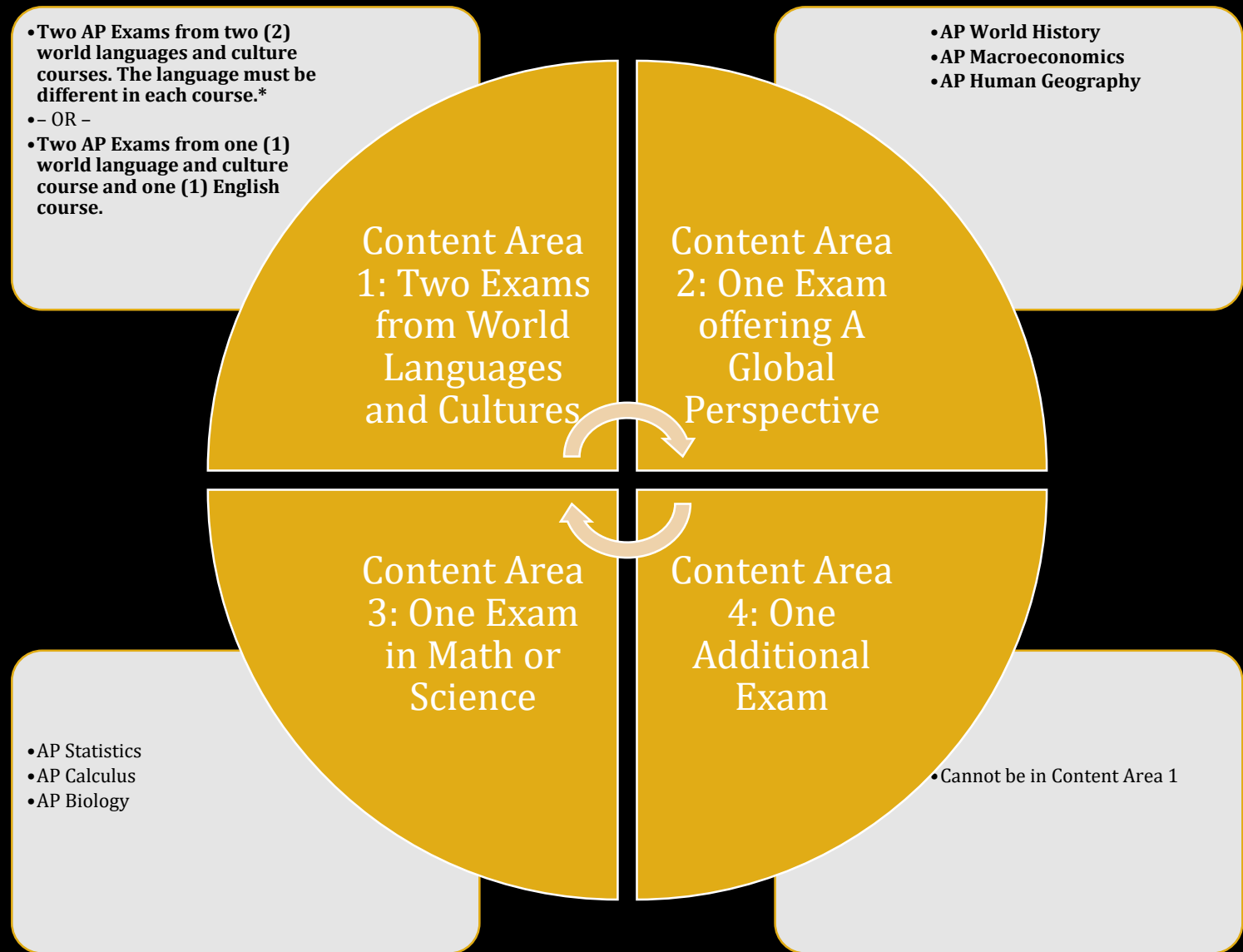
SIS Honors Diploma

The minimum requirements plus...



AP International Diploma

Earned through passing exams with a minimum of 3 on each exam



AP Scholars

Don't stop at the minimum!!!

AP Scholar

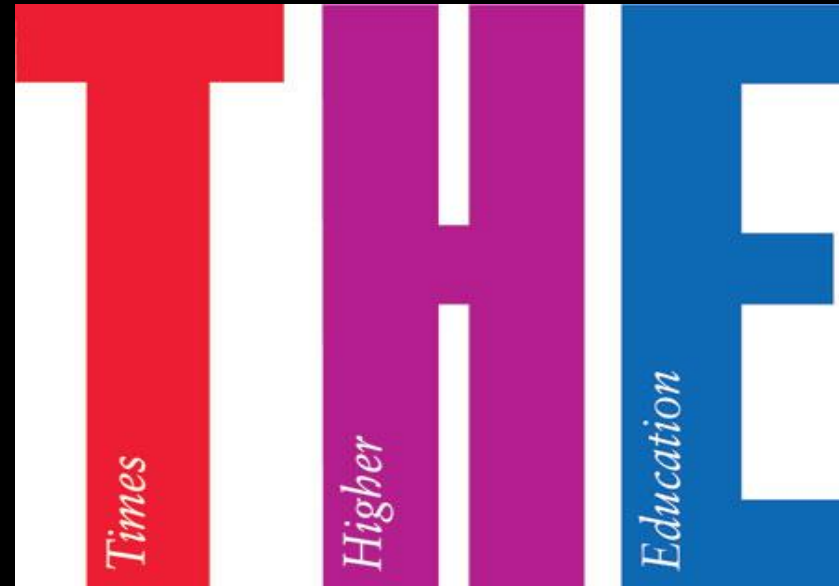
- Granted to students who receive scores of 3 or higher on three or more AP Exams

AP Scholar with Honor

- Granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.25 on all AP Exams taken, **and** scores of 3 or higher on four or more of these exams

AP Scholar with Distinction

- Granted to students who receive an average score of at least 3.5 on all AP Exams taken, **and** scores of 3 or higher on five or more of these exams
