Elementary School (K4-5th Grade):

6th to 12th Grade

We have developed a signup sheet that is on the web, so you can sign up for conferences with the teachers from grades 6-12 electronically. The process is simple, and link will be emailed to you. This link will take you to our sign-up sheet. The teacher's names and the conference times (10 minutes) are along the sides. Each teacher and time has a button that says "Sign Up". If a time has a person's name, then that appointment time has been taken. You choose the time you want to meet with a teacher and click on the Sign Up button. That will take you to a page that asks for the following information:

Name: Type in your name

Student Name: Type in your child's name

Email: Type in your email address

Telephone: Type in your telephone number

Undo Code: Type in a password that you can use to change your reservation time. (Optional)

When you have entered that information, hit Enter or click. That should take you back to the sign-up sheet to check your appointment and make another appointment if you wish. That's all there is to it. Your appointment is complete.
