IMPORTANT Reminder for Vaccine Administration

All students must have their immunization records up to dated. If the shots have been received at a private Clinic, parents must bring the proof to the Immunization Clinic at CHC, so they can update your child's records.



Pursuant to Public Law 6-10 all children in the CNMI must be up to date with their immunizations. This process is due January 31st. Failure to do so may result in your child being suspended from school until all immunizations are met.

The process is simple and doesn't take much time.

If you have the records or proof of your child's immunizations from other clinic or other city and/or country, please bring them to the CHC Clinic, so they will be able to update your child's records and release "A School Entrance Health Certificate" (Blue Card). This process must be done by the parents not by school.
